

HOUSE BILL NO. 4052

January 28, 2021, Introduced by Rep. Hoitenga and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Tourism.

A bill to provide for the official time followed in this state; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. (1) If the United States Congress amends 15 USC 260a
2 to authorize states to observe daylight saving time year-round, it
3 is the intent of the legislature that daylight saving time shall be
4 the year-round standard time of this state and all of its political
5 subdivisions in that part of this state that is in the Eastern

1 Standard Time zone and in that part of this state that is in the
2 Central Standard Time zone.

3 (2) It is the intent of the legislature that the time change
4 described in subsection (1) take effect only if all of the
5 following states observe daylight saving time year-round:

6 (a) Wisconsin.

7 (b) Illinois.

8 (c) Indiana.

9 (d) Ohio.

10 (e) Pennsylvania.

11 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
12 date it is enacted into law.
