## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 68. (1) The Subject to subsection (4), the retirement
- 2 board shall grant 1 year of service credit to a member who has been
- 3 employed and remunerated for services performed for not less than
- 4 1,020 hours in a school fiscal year. In determining whether a
- 5 member is entitled to service credit under this subsection, the
