A bill to prohibit the use of volunteer law enforcement officers by municipalities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
 "prohibition of volunteer law enforcement act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Law enforcement department" means a regularly organized
- 5 police department, sheriff's department, department of public
- 6 safety, or other similar organization that meets all of the

- 1 following requirements:
- 2 (i) Has as its primary purpose the enforcement of state or
- 3 local penal laws and the preservation of public order.
- $\mathbf{4}$ (ii) Consists wholly of paid law enforcement officers,
- 5 volunteer law enforcement officers, or a combination of volunteer
- 6 and paid law enforcement officers.
- 7 (iii) Is organized and maintained by a municipality.
- 8 (b) "Law enforcement officer" means that term as defined in
- 9 section 2 of the Michigan commission on law enforcement standards
- 10 act, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.602.
- 11 (c) "Municipality" means a city, village, or township.
- 12 (d) "Volunteer law enforcement officer" means an individual
- 13 who is a member of a law enforcement department and who meets all
- 14 of the following requirements:
- 15 (i) Is not licensed under the Michigan commission on law
- 16 enforcement standards act, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.601 to 28.615, as a
- 17 law enforcement officer.
- (ii) Performs assigned or authorized duties for the law
- 19 enforcement department by his or her own free choice.
- 20 (iii) Serves in a position that is not clerical or secretarial
- 21 in nature.
- 22 (iv) Is registered and accepted as a volunteer by the law
- 23 enforcement department.
- 24 (v) Receives no monetary remuneration other than maintenance
- 25 and reimbursement for actual expenses necessarily incurred in
- 26 performing assigned duties.
- Sec. 3. Beginning 1 year after the effective date of this act,
- 28 a municipality maintaining or operating a law enforcement
- 29 department shall not use a volunteer law enforcement officer.
