A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 946.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 946. (1) The secretary of state shall not accept from an
- 2 individual or entity, either directly or indirectly, a gift
- 3 involving election-related equipment, including, but not limited
- 4 to, a gift involving election-related equipment that is to be
- 5 distributed by any means to a county, city, village, or township

- 1 clerk or to any other local election official.
- 2 (2) A county, city, village, or township clerk, or any other
- 3 local election official, shall not accept from an individual or
- 4 entity, either directly or indirectly, a gift involving election-
- 5 related equipment.
- 6 (3) As used in this section:
- 7 (a) "Election-related equipment" means any materials,
- 8 machines, or products that may be used to facilitate any tasks
- 9 related to an election including, but not limited to, tabulators,
- 10 voting booths, and absent voter ballot drop boxes.
- 11 (b) "Gift involving election-related equipment" means any of
- 12 the following:
- 13 (i) A gift of property or goods involving election-related
- 14 equipment.
- 15 (ii) A gift of money or other consideration to be used for
- 16 obtaining election-related equipment.
