

HOUSE BILL NO. 5333

September 22, 2021, Introduced by Reps. Steven Johnson, Alexander, Calley, Paquette, Bollin, Lightner, Damoose, Outman and Yaroach and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to prohibit the expenditure of state money and use of state resources to implement or enforce certain federal laws related to COVID-19.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Employer" means a person that employs 1 or more
- 3 individuals in this state.
- 4 (b) "Person" means an individual or a partnership,
- 5 corporation, limited liability company, association, governmental

1 entity, or other legal entity.

2 (c) "State money" means money in the state treasury or any
3 other fund of this state.

4 (d) "State resources" means any of the following:

5 (i) A building or real property owned or leased by this state.

6 (ii) Equipment or personal property owned or leased by this
7 state.

8 (iii) An employee of this state.

9 Sec. 3. This state shall not expend state money or use state
10 resources to implement or enforce, or assist in implementing or
11 enforcing, a federal law that requires an employer to require its
12 employees to do either of the following:

13 (a) Be tested for COVID-19.

14 (b) Receive a COVID-19 vaccination.
