## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5390**

October 13, 2021, Introduced by Reps. Steven Johnson and Beson and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 43523a (MCL 324.43523a), as amended by 2018 PA 3.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 43523a. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this part, an
- 2 individual shall not hunt small game, unless the individual
- 3 possesses a current base license. A base license authorizes the
- 4 individual named in the license to hunt for small game, except for

- 1 animals or birds that require a special license.
- 2 (2) If authorized in an order issued under part 401, an
- 3 individual who possesses a current base license may take specified
- 4 fur-bearing animals by means other than trapping during the open
- 5 season for hunting these fur-bearing animals. However, an
- 6 individual who goes on a bobcat hunt with a licensed hunter is not
- 7 required to possess a base license if the individual does not carry
- 8 a firearm, bow, or crossbow and does not own dogs used to chase or
- 9 locate a bobcat during the hunt.
- 10 (3) The fee for a base license is as follows:
- 11 (a) Subject to subdivision (b), for a resident, \$10.00.
- 12 (b) For a resident minor child or nonresident minor child,
- **13** \$5.00.
- 14 (c) Subject to subdivision (b), for a nonresident, \$150.00.
- 15 (4) A base license is void between the hours of 1/2 hour after
- 16 sunset and 1/2 hour before sunrise with the exception of coyote
- 17 hunting.
- 18 (5) A nonresident may purchase a limited nonresident small
- 19 game license entitling that individual to hunt for a 7-day period
- 20 all species of small game that are available to hunt under a
- 21 nonresident base license. The fee for a 7-day limited nonresident
- 22 small game license is \$80.00. Except for the purchase of a
- 23 waterfowl hunting license under section 43525b, the purchase of a
- 24 7-day limited nonresident small game license does not entitle the
- 25 holder to purchase any additional licenses.
- 26 (6) Beginning March 1, 2018, a A nonresident may purchase a 3-
- 27 day limited nonresident small game license entitling that
- 28 individual to hunt for a 3-day period all species of small game
- 29 that are available to hunt under a nonresident base license. The

- 1 fee for a 3-day limited nonresident small game license is \$50.00.
- 2 Except for the purchase of a waterfowl hunting license issued under
- 3 section 43525b, the purchase of a 3-day limited nonresident small
- 4 game license does not entitle the holder to purchase any additional
- 5 licenses.
- 6 (7) An individual may hunt squirrel year-round in this state 7 without a license.
- 8 (8) (7) Not later than March 1, 2018, the The department shall
- 9 develop an electronic license that allows an individual to display
- 10 an electronic copy of his or her base license using an electronic
- 11 device.
