## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5471**

October 21, 2021, Introduced by Reps. Anthony, Aiyash, Breen, Huizenga, Cavanagh, Hood, Tyrone Carter, Ellison, Bolden, Green, Scott, Young, Puri and Camilleri and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 222, entitled

"An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to regulate the use and disclosure of information obtained from the card; to prescribe the powers and duties of the secretary of state; to prescribe fees; to prescribe certain penalties for violations; and to provide an appropriation for certain purposes,"

(MCL 28.291 to 28.300) by adding section 1b.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1b. (1) The secretary of state shall make the official
- 2 state personal identification card issued under this act available

- 1 in a digital format.
- 2 (2) The secretary of state may enter into a contract with a
- 3 vendor in order to make digitized official state personal
- 4 identification cards issued pursuant to this section available in
- 5 this state.
- 6 (3) A digitized official state personal identification card
- 7 issued pursuant to this section must contain all of the following:
- 8 (a) Information appearing in electronic or machine-readable
- 9 codes needed to conduct a transaction with the secretary of state.
- 10 (b) A QR code that allows the digitized official state
- 11 personal identification card to be scanned and read.
- 12 (c) Information described in section 2(1)(a) and (b) except
- 13 for the individual's digital photographic image and signature or
- 14 verification and certification, state of issuance, and other
- 15 information necessary for use with electronic devices, machine
- 16 readers, or automatic teller machines and must not contain the
- 17 individual's driving record or other personal identifier. The
- 18 digitized official state personal identification card must identify
- 19 the encoded information.
- 20 (4) A digitized official state personal identification card
- 21 may contain an identifier for voter registration purposes.
- 22 (5) As used in this section:
- 23 (a) "QR code" means a machine-readable code consisting of an
- 24 array of black and white squares used for storing information for
- 25 reading by the camera on a smart cellular telephone or other
- 26 handheld technology.
- 27 (b) "Smart cellular telephone" or "other handheld technology"
- 28 means a cellular telephone or a similar handheld machine that
- 29 performs many of the functions of a computer, typically having a

- 1 touchscreen interface, internet access, and an operating system
- 2 capable of running downloaded applications.
