12 GENERAL SECTIONS

13 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state
 14 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under
 15 part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022 is
 16 \$50,000,000.00 and total state spending from state sources to be
 17 paid to local units of government is \$50,000,000.00.

18 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
 19 under this part and part 1 and the departments, commissions,
 20 boards, offices, and programs for which appropriations are made
 21 under this part and part 1 are subject to the management and budget
 22 act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

24 DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, GREAT LAKES, AND ENERGY

25 Sec. 301. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 for Great Lakes
 26 Water Authority bad debt surcharge reimbursement shall be allocated
 27 to the GLWA to be used to reimburse customers that paid increased
 28 sewer and water service charges as a result of the Highland Park
 29 bad debt expense recognized by the GLWA.

1 (2) If the amount allocated to the GLWA under subsection (1)
2 is insufficient to fully reimburse all customers for all amounts
3 paid for increased sewer and water service charges as a result of
4 the Highland Park bad debt expense recognized by the GLWA, the GLWA
5 must distribute the money on a pro rata basis.

6 (3) The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for Great
7 Lakes Water Authority bad debt surcharge reimbursement are
8 designated as a work project appropriation. Any unencumbered or
9 unallotted funds shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year and
10 shall be available for expenditures for the project under this
11 section until the project has been completed. The following is in
12 compliance with section 451a of the management and budget act, 1984
13 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:

14 (a) The purpose of the project is to reimburse customers that
15 paid increased sewer and water service charges as a result of the
16 Highland Park bad debt expense recognized by the GLWA.

17 (b) The project will be accomplished by utilizing state
18 employees or contracts.

19 (c) The total estimated cost of the project is \$50,000,000.00.

20 (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2026.

21 (4) As used in this section, "GLWA" means the Great Lakes
22 Water Authority.
