A bill to amend 2012 PA 411, entitled "Rural development fund act,"

by amending the title and section 7 (MCL 286.947) and by adding section 6a.

- 2 (4) Grants from the fund may be used to provide matching funds
- 3 for other available grants, as allowed by law.
