THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- (a) "Cat" means a domestic cat of the species Felis catus or ahybrid of that species. Cat includes, but is not limited to, a

- 1 abnormal condition in the claw of a cat that compromises the cat's
- 2 health. Therapeutic purpose does not include cosmetic or aesthetic
- 3 reasons or reasons of convenience in keeping or handling a cat.
- 4 Sec. 3. (1) An individual shall not perform by any means an
- 5 onychectomy, a partial or complete phalangectomy, or tendonectomy
- 6 procedure, or any other surgical procedure that prevents normal
- 7 functioning of the claws, on a cat in this state, unless the
- 8 procedure is necessary for a therapeutic purpose.
- 9 (2) An individual who violates this section is responsible for
- 10 a civil fine of not more than \$1,000.00. A violation of this
- 11 section may be prosecuted by the prosecutor of the county in which
- 12 the violation occurred, or by the attorney general.
