HOUSE BILL NO. 6544

December 01, 2022, Introduced by Rep. Pepper and referred to the Committee on Military, Veterans and Homeland Security.

A bill to ban the manufacture, possession, purchase, and sale of assault weapons; to provide certain powers and duties for certain state and local officials and agencies; to provide for the promulgation of rules; and to provide penalties.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. As used in this act, "assault weapon" means a
 semiautomatic rifle that has an ability to accept a detachable
 magazine and has 1 or more of the following characteristics:
- 4 (i) A pistol grip or thumbhole stock.
- 5 (ii) Any feature capable of functioning as a protruding grip6 that can be held by the nontrigger hand.

- 1 (iii) A folding or telescoping stock.
- (iv) A shroud that is attached to, or partially or completely
- 3 encircles, the barrel and that permits the shooter to hold the
- 4 firearm with the nontrigger hand without being burned, but
- 5 excluding a slide that encloses the barrel.
- 6 Sec. 2. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
- 7 beginning January 1, 2024, a person shall not manufacture, possess,
- 8 purchase, or sell an assault weapon in this state.
- 9 (2) A person may continue to possess an assault weapon that
- 10 the person legally possessed before the effective date of this act
- 11 if both of the following apply:
- 12 (a) The person registers the assault weapon with the
- 13 department of state police in compliance with rules adopted for
- 14 that purpose by the department of state police.
- 15 (b) The person renews the registration of the assault weapon
