SENATE BILL NO. 42

January 26, 2021, Introduced by Senator VICTORY and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 230, entitled "Stille-DeRossett-Hale single state construction code act," by amending section 10 (MCL 125.1510), as amended by 2016 PA 409.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 10. (1) Except as otherwise provided in the code, before
- 2 construction of a building or structure, the owner, or the owner's
- 3 builder, architect, engineer, or agent, shall submit an application
- 4 in writing to the appropriate enforcing agency for a building
- 5 permit. The application shall must be on a form prescribed by the
- 6 commission and shall must be accompanied by payment of the fee

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established by the enforcing agency. The application shall must 1 contain a detailed statement in writing, verified by affidavit of 2 3 the individual making it, of the specifications for the building or structure, and full and complete copies of the plans drawn to scale 4 of the proposed work. A site plan showing the dimensions, and the 5 6 location of the proposed building or structure and other buildings 7 or structures on the same premises, shall must be submitted with 8 the application. The application shall must state in full the name 9 and residence, by street and number, of the owner in fee of the

land on which the building or structure will be constructed, and the purposes for which it will be used.

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(2) If construction is proposed to be undertaken by a person other than the owner of the land in fee, the statement shall must contain the full name and residence, by street and number, of the owner and also of the person proposing the construction. The affidavit shall must state that the specifications and plans are true and complete and contain a correct description of the building or structure, lot or parcel, and proposed work. The statements and affidavits may be made by an owner, or the owner's attorney, agent, engineer, architect, or builder, by the person who that proposes to make the construction or alteration, or by that person's agent, engineer, architect, or builder. A person shall not be recognized as the agent, attorney, engineer, architect, or builder of another person unless the person seeking recognition files with the enforcing agency a written instrument, which shall must be an architectural, engineering, or construction contract, power of attorney, or letter of authorization signed by that other person designating that designates the person seeking recognition as the agent, attorney, architect, engineer, or builder and, in case of a

- 14 contractor under article 8 of the skilled trades regulation act,
- **2016 PA 407**, MCL 339.5801 to 339.5819, who applies for a building
- 16 permit to perform work on a residential building or a residential
- 17 structure shall, in addition to any other information required
- 18 pursuant to under this act, provide on the building permit
- 19 application all of the following information:
- 20 (a) The occupational license number of the applicant and the
- 21 expiration date of the occupational license.
- 22 (b) One of the following:
- 23 (i) The If the applicant is required to be insured under the

- 3 (4) The building permit application form shall must contain
 4 the following statement in 8-point boldfaced type immediately above
 5 the location for the applicant's signature:
- "Section 23a of the Stille-DeRossett-Hale single state
 construction code act, of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523a,
 prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent circumventing the
 licensing requirements of this state relating to for persons who
 are to perform work on a residential building or a residential
 structure. Violators of section 23a are subjected subject to civil
 fines."

- (5) The application for a building permit shall must be filed with the enforcing agency and the application and any other writing prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or retained by the enforcing agency in the performance of an official function shall must be made available to the public in compliance with the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 to 15.246. An application shall must not be removed from the custody of the enforcing agency after a building permit has been issued.

- 3 (7) A building permit is not required for ordinary repairs of

- 7 which the building is located if the building is not used in the
- 8 business of retail trade.
- **9** (9) A qualifying roadside stand is exempt from the plumbing
- 10 fixture requirements of this act and the code and is not required
- 11 to have electric power. However, a A qualifying roadside stand that
- 12 has electric power must comply with the electrical code. This
- 13 subsection does not exempt a qualifying roadside stand from a
- 14 requirement to obtain a building permit. As used in this
- 15 subsection, "qualifying roadside stand" means a roadside stand that
- 16 meets all of the following requirements:
- 17 (a) Is used only for seasonal retail trade in agricultural
- 18 products.
- 19 (b) At least 50% of the agricultural products offered for sale
- 20 at the roadside stand are produced on a farm that is owned or
- 21 controlled by the person who that owns the roadside stand.
- (c) Is not larger than 400 square feet.
- 23 (d) Is securely anchored to the ground.
- 24 (10) A tent that meets the requirements of subsection (9)(a),
- 25 (b), and (c) is exempt from this act and the code.
- 26 (11) A building or structure, whether temporary or permanent,
- 27 incidental to the use for agricultural purposes of the land on
- 28 which the building is located that is used for agricultural tourism
- 29 activities is exempt from this act and the code if the total

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- 1 revenue generated from those activities is less than 50% of the
- 2 total revenue generated by all farm operations and the building is
- 3 used for those activities for a period not exceeding 6 months in a
- 4 calendar year. As used in this subsection:
- 5 (a) "Agricultural tourism activity" means an activity
- 6 conducted on a farm that provides an educational or entertainment
- 7 experience, directly or indirectly related to farm operations, to
- 8 the general public for the purpose of increasing the total revenue
- 9 of the farm business.
- 10 (b) "Farm" and "farm operation" mean those terms as defined in
- 11 section 2 of the Michigan right to farm act, 1981 PA 93, MCL
