

SENATE BILL NO. 78

February 02, 2021, Introduced by Senator HORN and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to provide for a capital outlay program and for certain state departments; to implement the program in the budgetary process; to make appropriations for planning and construction at state institutions and the acquisition of land; to provide for the elimination of fire hazards at the institutions; to provide for special maintenance, remodeling, renovation, or demolition of structures and additions to projects at state institutions; to provide for elimination of occupational safety and health hazards at state agencies and institutions; to provide for the awarding of contracts; and to provide for the expenditure of appropriations

under the supervision of the director of the department of technology, management, and budget and the state administrative board.

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PART 1

LINE-ITEM APPROPRIATIONS

Sec. 101. Subject to part 2, there is appropriated from the general fund of this state for special maintenance projects for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022, \$900.00 or as much of that amount as necessary.
