A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1233d.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1233d. (1) Beginning on the effective date of the
- 2 amendatory act that added this section through June 30, 2026, if
- 3 the department issues a daily substitute permit to an individual
- 4 during a period when an unusual and extenuating circumstance
- 5 resulting from conditions not within the control of school

- 1 authorities of the school in which the individual is assigned to
- 2 substitute teach, including, but not limited to, a natural
- 3 disaster, an emergency school closure, or an emergency health
- 4 condition as defined by city, county, or state health authorities

- 7 this subsection, the school district, intermediate school district,

- (a) The permit is issued to an individual who has completed at
- 24 least 60 semester hours of satisfactory credit combined from 1 or
- 25 more regionally accredited 2- or 4-year colleges or universities.
- 26 As used in this subdivision, "satisfactory credit" means obtaining
- 27 a grade of C or better for the credit.
- 28 (b) The permit, as initially issued, before the application of
- 29 an automatic extension under subsection (1), permits an individual

- 1 described in subdivision (a) to substitute teach in the public
- 2 schools of this state in 1 teaching assignment for not more than 90
- 3 calendar days when a teacher is temporarily unavailable.
