A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending sections 43527a, 43528b, and 43532 (MCL 324.43527a, 324.43528b, and 324.43532), section 43527a as added by 2013 PA 108, section 43528b as amended by 2013 PA 108, and section 43532 as amended by 2020 PA 271.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 43527a. (1) Beginning March 1, 2014, only Only an
- 2 individual holding a valid base license is eligible to purchase a

- **6** (3) The department may issue a kill tag with or as part of
- 7 each deer license. The kill tag shall must bear the license number.
- 8 The kill tag may also include space for other pertinent information

- 11 (4) Where authorized by the department, a resident may

- 28 nonresident all-species fishing license is \$75.00. \$68.00. Until 5

- 1 section 43523c or until the department stops offering discounted
- 2 licenses as provided in section 43523c, for a qualified
- 3 nonresident, the fee for a nonresident all-species fishing license
- 4 is \$34.00. An individual under 17 years of age may take and possess
- 5 aquatic species in the waters over which this state has
- 6 jurisdiction without an all-species fishing license. However, an
- 7 individual under 17 years of age may obtain an all-species fishing
- 8 license. The fee for a resident or nonresident who is under 17
- 9 years of age for an all-species fishing license is \$2.00.
- 10 (3) The department shall develop an electronic license that
- 11 allows an individual to display an electronic copy of his or her
- 12 all-species fishing license using an electronic device.
- 13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 14 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 15 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 16 unless Senate Bill No. 269 of the 101st Legislature is enacted into
- **17** law.
