THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 31b. Not later than July 1 of each odd numbered year, and
- 2 not later than March 1 and July 1 of each even numbered year, the

- Sec. 946. (1) This state, a department, agency, commission, or
- 3 board of this state, or a county, city, village, or township shall
- 4 not accept from an individual or entity, either directly or
- 5 indirectly, a gift of money or other consideration to be used for
- 6 an election related activity or for election related equipment.
- 7 (2) As used in this section:
- 8 (a) "Election related activity" includes, but is not limited
- 9 to, voter registration, voter eligibility review, mailing of
- 10 election materials, sharing of voter information, creation or
- 11 dissemination of advertisements about an election, or recruiting
- 12 and hiring precinct election inspectors.
- 13 (b) "Election related equipment" includes, but is not limited
- 14 to, tabulators, communication devices, signs, tents, voting
- 15 facilities or locations, or absent voter ballot drop boxes.
