March 25, 2021, Introduced by Senators RUNESTAD, JOHNSON, DALEY, BUMSTEAD, ZORN, STAMAS, BARRETT, THEIS, LASATA, NESBITT, VANDERWALL, LAUWERS, VICTORY and SCHMIDT and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for various state departments and agencies and the legislative branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

PART 2

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

GENERAL SECTIONS

Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 is \$250,000.00 and total state spending from state sources to be paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under this part and part 1 and the departments, commissions, boards, offices, and programs for which appropriations are made under this part and part 1 are subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

Sec. 203. If the state administrative board, acting under section 3 of 1921 PA 2, MCL 17.3, transfers funds from an amount appropriated under this act, the legislature may, by a concurrent resolution adopted by a majority of the members elected to and serving in each house, inter-transfer funds within this act for the particular department, board, commission, office, or institution.

LEGISLATURE

Sec. 301. From the funds appropriated in part 1, the COVID-19 special investigator shall pursue an appropriate and reasonable

1 investigation into the long-term care and residential care facility
2 policies implemented by the governor and the Michigan department of
3 health and human services, and the reported data on infection and
4 transmission rates, tracking, tracing, and number of deaths
5 associated with these facilities during the COVID-19 pandemic.

6 Sec. 302. The COVID-19 special investigator shall provide, on
7 at least a quarterly basis until 6 months after the investigation
8 has been completed, public updates on the status of the
9 investigation to the senate committee on health policy and human
10 services and the house committee on health policy.
