A bill to amend 1936 (Ex Sess) PA 1, entitled "Michigan employment security act,"

(MCL 421.1 to 421.75) by adding section 69.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 69. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act,
- 2 the unemployment agency shall not enter into an agreement with a
- 3 third party to perform a duty of the unemployment agency prescribed
- 4 to it by law unless both of the following conditions are met:
- 5 (a) The third party does both of the following:
- 6 (i) Obtains a criminal history background check conducted by a

- 1 law enforcement agency of each of the third party's employees or
- 2 independent contractors who will be involved in performing the duty
- 3 of the unemployment agency.
- 4 (ii) Provides to the unemployment agency the results of all of
- 5 the criminal history background checks described in subparagraph
- 6 (i).
- 7 (b) The agreement requires the third party to do both of the
- 8 following:
- 9 (i) Obtain a criminal history background check conducted by a
- 10 law enforcement agency of each of the third party's employees or
- 11 independent contractors who are hired or engaged during the term of
- 12 the contract and who will be involved in performing the duty of the
- 13 unemployment agency.
- 14 (ii) Provide to the unemployment agency the results of all of
- 15 the criminal history background checks described in subparagraph
- 16 (i).
- 17 (2) The unemployment agency shall do both of the following
- 18 with respect to third parties that have provided criminal history
- 19 background checks to the unemployment agency under subsection (1):
- 20 (a) Maintain a list of the third parties.
- 21 (b) Designate 1 or more employees whose duty it is to ensure
- 22 that the third parties comply with this section and the terms of an
- 23 agreement described in subsection (1).
