THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 10251. (1) A person that performs organ transplants in
- 2 this state shall not refuse to transplant an organ in a transplant
- 3 recipient who is physically or mentally disabled based solely on
- 4 the transplant recipient's physical or mental disability.
 - (2) A person that performs organ transplants in this state

- 1 shall not refuse to transplant an organ in a transplant recipient
- 2 based on an assessment that the recipient will be unable, without
- 3 support, to comply with post-transplantation medical requirements
- 4 because of a mental disability. A person that performs organ
- 5 transplants in this state shall consider a transplant recipient's
- 6 support in determining the recipient's ability to comply with post-
- 7 transplantation medical requirements.
- 8 (3) A person that violates this section may be restrained or
- 9 enjoined from violating this section in an injunctive action as
- 10 otherwise provided by law. The injunctive action must be heard in
- 11 an expedited manner.
- 12 (4) As used in this section, "organ" means that term as
- 13 defined in section 10102.
