## **SENATE BILL NO. 639**

September 15, 2021, Introduced by Senator ZORN and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 42 (MCL 257.42), as amended by 2021 PA 43.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 42. "Police officer" means any of the following:
- 2 (a) A sheriff or sheriff's deputy.
- 3 (b) A village or township marshal.
- 4 (c) An officer of the police department of any city, village,
- 5 or township.

- 1 (d) An officer of the department of state police.
- 2 (e) A peace officer or law enforcement officer who is licensed
- 3 under the Michigan commission on law enforcement standards act,
- 4 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.601 to 28.615.
- 5 (f) For purposes of enforcing sections 215, 255, 631(1) other
- 6 than for speed by noncommercial vehicle operators, 717, 719, 719a,
- 7 720, 722, 724, 725, and 726, a duly authorized agent of a county
- 8 road commission meeting the requirements of section 726c. However,
- 9 an authorized agent of a county road commission shall only enforce
- 10 sections 215 and 255 with respect to commercial vehicles. Except as
- 11 provided in section 726c(2), an authorized agent of a county road
- 12 commission is not required to be licensed under the Michigan
- 13 commission on law enforcement standards act, 1965 PA 203, MCL
- 14 28.601 to 28.615, to enforce any law described in this subdivision.
- 15 (g) A transit police officer employed by a public body
- 16 corporate established and maintained pursuant to an interlocal
- 17 agreement under the urban cooperation act of 1967, 1967 (Ex Sess)
- **18** PA 7, MCL 124.501 to 124.512, between a city that is authorized by
- 19 the laws of this state to appoint or employ law enforcement
- 20 officers and an authority under the metropolitan transportation
- 21 authorities act of 1967, 1967 PA 204, MCL 124.401 to 124.426, who
- 22 is licensed under the Michigan commission on law enforcement
- 23 standards act, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.601 to 28.615.
- 24 (h) A traffic control officer employed by a county, city,
- 25 village, or township. For purposes of enforcing this act, both of
- 26 the following apply:
- 27 (i) A traffic control officer shall only perform the duties and
- 28 responsibilities that are stated in his or her job description as a
- 29 traffic control officer.

- 1 (ii) A traffic control officer shall not carry a firearm unless
- 2 he or she is licensed as a police officer under the Michigan
- 3 commission on law enforcement standards act, 1965 PA 203, MCL
- 4 28.601 to 28.615.
