

SENATE BILL NO. 812

January 12, 2022, Introduced by Senators VANDERWALL, NESBITT, HOLLIER, ZORN, WOJNO, HERTEL, CHANG, IRWIN, WOZNIAK and DALEY and referred to the Committee on Health Policy and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
by amending section 20199 (MCL 333.20199) and by adding part 216A.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 20199. (1) Except as **otherwise** provided in subsection (2)
2 or ~~section 20142,~~ **this article**, a person who violates this article
3 or a rule promulgated or an order issued under this article is
4 guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by **a** fine of not more than
5 \$1,000.00 for each day the violation continues or, ~~in case of~~ **for** a

violation of sections 20551 to 20554, a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 for each occurrence.

(2) A person who violates sections 20181 to 20184 is guilty of a misdemeanor ~~—~~punishable by imprisonment for not more than 6 months ~~—~~or a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, or both.

PART 216A. SPECIALIZED LABORATORIES

Sec. 21651. (1) As used in this part:

(a) "Cardiac catheterization laboratory" means a facility, other than a hospital or freestanding surgical outpatient facility, in which diagnostic and therapeutic procedures are performed on patients with cardiovascular disease.

(b) "Kidney dialysis laboratory" means a facility, other than a hospital or freestanding surgical outpatient facility, in which diagnostic and therapeutic procedures are performed on patients with kidney disease or cardiovascular disease.

(c) "Pain management laboratory" means a facility, other than a hospital or freestanding surgical outpatient facility, in which the following are performed on patients:

(i) Diagnostic and therapeutic procedures to ease pain and provide symptom management.

(ii) Procedures related to cardiovascular disease.

(d) "Specialized laboratory" means a cardiac catheterization laboratory, kidney dialysis laboratory, pain management laboratory, or vascular laboratory.

(e) "Vascular laboratory" means a facility, other than a hospital or freestanding surgical outpatient facility, in which diagnostic and therapeutic procedures are performed on patients with vascular disease.

(2) In addition, article 1 contains general definitions and

1 principles of construction applicable to all articles in this code
2 and part 201 contains definitions applicable to this part.

3 Sec. 21653. (1) Beginning 180 days after the effective date of
4 the amendatory act that added this section, a person that
5 establishes or operates a specialized laboratory shall register the
6 specialized laboratory with the department on a form and in a
7 manner required by the department.

8 (2) A registration is valid for 1 year and may be renewed on
9 application.

10 Sec. 21655. Both of the following apply to a person that
11 violates this part:

12 (a) The person is subject to an administrative fine of \$100.00
13 for each day that the violation continues. The department shall
14 provide notice and an opportunity for a hearing in the same manner
15 as provided in section 20166.

16 (b) The person is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine
17 of not more than \$5,000.00.
