

SENATE BILL NO. 1069

June 09, 2022, Introduced by Senators JOHNSON, RUNESTAD, BIZON, VICTORY, LAUWERS and WOZNIAK and referred to the Committee on Elections.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 932b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 932b. (1) A person shall not, either directly or
2 indirectly, give, lend, or promise any money or other consideration
3 to the secretary of state, a county, city, township, or village, or
4 any election official in this state to influence, either directly
5 or indirectly, the electors to vote in person or by absent voter

1 ballot.

2 (2) A person who knowingly violates this section is guilty of
3 a felony punishable as follows:

4 (a) If the person is an individual, by imprisonment for not
5 more than 5 years or a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.

6 (b) If the person is not an individual, by a fine of not more
7 than \$100,000.00.
