

SENATE BILL NO. 1228

November 29, 2022, Introduced by Senators ANANICH, GEISS and CHANG and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
by amending section 2821 (MCL 333.2821), as amended by 1996 PA 540.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 2821. (1) Birth registration is required for each
2 individual born in this state.

3 (2) A record of birth for each live birth that occurs in this
4 state ~~shall~~**must** be filed at the office of the local registrar not
5 more than 5 days after the birth. The birth ~~shall~~**must** be

1 registered when the filing is completed.

2 (3) ~~Upon~~ **The state registrar shall comply with both of the**
3 **following:**

4 (a) **On the** receipt of a vital record consisting of a birth
5 registration transmitted by a local registrar pursuant to section
6 2815(2), the state registrar shall transmit the information
7 contained in the birth registration to the childhood immunization
8 registry created in section 9207.

9 (b) **No later than 90 days after the receipt of a vital record**
10 **consisting of a birth registration transmitted by a local registrar**
11 **pursuant to section 2815(2), the state registrar shall transmit the**
12 **information contained in the birth registration to the department**
13 **of treasury for purposes of the Michigan kids investment and**
14 **development savings program established under the Michigan kids**
15 **investment and development savings (KIDS) program act.**

16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
17 unless Senate Bill No. 1229 of the 101st Legislature is enacted
18 into law.
