

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.2

Reps. Glenn, Aiyash, Allor, Brabec, Breen, Brixie, Cherry, Garza, Haadsma, Hammoud, Kuppa, Lasinski, Liberati, Morse, Pohutsky, Rogers, Scott, Weiss, Witwer and Young offered the following concurrent resolution:

1 A concurrent resolution to recognize the victims lost to
2 COVID-19 and to express our most sincere condolences to the
3 families that have lost loved ones to COVID-19.

4 Whereas, The novel coronavirus, also commonly referred to as
5 COVID-19, is a global pandemic that attacks the respiratory system
6 and puts lives at risk. Far too many patients with the most severe
7 complications have developed pneumonia or even perished because of
8 COVID-19. Older adults and people with underlying health conditions
9 have a greater risk of developing a serious illness and have

1 experienced disproportionate loss; and

2 Whereas, There have been over 562,000 COVID-19 cases in
3 Michigan since March 10, 2020, when the first presumptive positive
4 cases were identified in our state; and

5 Whereas, There have been over 14,600 lives lost in Michigan
6 because of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

7 Whereas, Many families have been unable to say goodbye to
8 loved ones or mourn properly as a result of COVID-19. These
9 precious lives lost are mothers, fathers, sisters, brothers,
10 grandmothers, grandfathers, aunts, uncles, nieces, and nephews that
11 were taken from their lives and their loved ones too soon; and

12 Whereas, There are still Michiganders fighting for their life
13 while battling the effects of COVID-19; now, therefore, be it

14 Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate
15 concurring), That the members of this legislative body recognize
16 the victims lost to COVID-19 and express our most sincere
17 condolences to the families that have lost loved ones to COVID-19.
