## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 25

Senators Stamas and Schmidt offered the following concurrent resolution:

A concurrent resolution to waive the legislative notice
 requirement for increases in rates of compensation for certain
 employees in the state classified service.

Whereas, Article XI, Section 5 of the *Constitution of the*State of Michigan of 1963 provides, in relevant part:

Increases in rates of compensation authorized by the commission may be effective only at the start of a fiscal year and shall require prior notice to the governor, who shall transmit such increases to the legislature as part of his budget. The legislature may, by a majority vote of the members elected to and serving in each house, waive the notice and permit increases in rates of compensation

- to be effective at a time other than the start of a fiscal

- 4 Whereas, As a result of recently completed negotiations, a
- 5 settlement has been reached on a contract between the state and the
- 6 Michigan State Police Troopers Association regarding compensation
- 7 and other terms and conditions of employment. This settlement was
- 8 reached past the time when the Governor could transmit the increase
- 9 as part of the budget; and

- 17 notice requirement to permit increases in rates of compensation for

- 19 contract settled between the Michigan State Police Troopers
- 20 Association and the state and the Civil Service Commission; and be
