

THIS RESOLUTION IS OFFERED TO COMPLY WITH ARTICLE XI, SECTION 5 OF
THE *CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN OF 1963*.

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 25

Senators Stamas and Schmidt offered the following concurrent
resolution:

1 A concurrent resolution to waive the legislative notice
2 requirement for increases in rates of compensation for certain
3 employees in the state classified service.

4 Whereas, Article XI, Section 5 of the *Constitution of the*
5 *State of Michigan of 1963* provides, in relevant part:

6 Increases in rates of compensation authorized by the
7 commission may be effective only at the start of a fiscal
8 year and shall require prior notice to the governor, who
9 shall transmit such increases to the legislature as part
10 of his budget. The legislature may, by a majority vote of
11 the members elected to and serving in each house, waive
12 the notice and permit increases in rates of compensation

1 to be effective at a time other than the start of a fiscal
2 year.

4 Whereas, As a result of recently completed negotiations, a
5 settlement has been reached on a contract between the state and the
6 Michigan State Police Troopers Association regarding compensation
7 and other terms and conditions of employment. This settlement was
8 reached past the time when the Governor could transmit the increase
9 as part of the budget; and

10 Whereas, The State Personnel Director, with the consent of the
11 chair of the Civil Service Commission, granted interim approval of
12 the collective bargaining agreement on February 8, 2022; now,
13 therefore, be it

14 Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives
15 concurring), That, pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the
16 *Constitution of the State of Michigan of 1963*, we waive the prior
17 notice requirement to permit increases in rates of compensation for
18 certain members of the Department of State Police as set in the
19 contract settled between the Michigan State Police Troopers
20 Association and the state and the Civil Service Commission; and be
21 it further

22 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
23 members of the Civil Service Commission.
