SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 27

Senators Shirkey and McBroom offered the following concurrent
resolution:

1 A concurrent resolution to reappoint Doug A. Ringler, C.P.A.,
2 C.I.A., as Auditor General.

3 Whereas, Article IV, Section 53 of the *Constitution of the*
4 *State of Michigan of 1963* requires the Legislature, by a majority
5 vote of the members elected to and serving in each house, to
6 appoint an Auditor General, who shall be a certified public
7 accountant licensed to practice in this state, to serve for a term
8 of eight years; and

9 Whereas, Under the provisions of Article IV, Section 53, the
10 Auditor General of the state of Michigan shall conduct post audits
11 of financial transactions and accounts of the state and of all
12 branches, departments, offices, boards, commissions, agencies,

1 authorities, and institutions established by the state constitution
2 or by law, and performance post audits; and

3 Whereas, In 2014, the Legislature appointed Doug A. Ringler,
4 C.P.A., C.I.A., as Auditor General of the state of Michigan,
5 pursuant to House Concurrent Resolution 28, for a term of eight
6 years, effective June 9, 2014; now, therefore, be it

7 Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives
8 concurring), That, pursuant to Article IV, Section 53 of the
9 *Constitution of the State of Michigan of 1963*, we hereby reappoint
10 Doug A. Ringler, C.P.A., C.I.A., as Auditor General of the state of
11 Michigan, to serve for a term of eight years, effective June 9,
12 2022.
