

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.2

Rep. Glenn offered the following concurrent resolution:

1 A concurrent resolution to recognize the victims lost to
2 COVID-19 and to express our most sincere condolences to the
3 families that have lost loved ones to COVID-19.

4 Whereas, The novel coronavirus, also commonly referred to as
5 COVID-19, is a global pandemic that attacks the respiratory system
6 and puts lives at risk. Far too many patients with the most severe
7 complications have developed pneumonia or even perished because of
8 COVID-19. Older adults and people with underlying health conditions
9 have a greater risk of developing a serious illness and have
10 experienced disproportionate loss; and

11 Whereas, There have been over 562,000 COVID-19 cases in
12 Michigan since March 10, 2020, when the first presumptive positive

1 cases were identified in our state; and

2 Whereas, There have been over 14,600 lives lost in Michigan
3 because of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

4 Whereas, Many families have been unable to say goodbye to
5 loved ones or mourn properly as a result of COVID-19. These
6 precious lives lost are mothers, fathers, sisters, brothers,
7 grandmothers, grandfathers, aunts, uncles, nieces, and nephews that
8 were taken from their lives and their loved ones too soon; and

9 Whereas, There are still Michiganders fighting for their life
10 while battling the effects of COVID-19; now, therefore, be it

11 Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate
12 concurring), That the members of this legislative body recognize
13 the victims lost to COVID-19 and express our most sincere
14 condolences to the families that have lost loved ones to COVID-19.
15 We take a moment of silence to mourn these victims.
