A concurrent resolution to waive the legislative notice
requirement for increases in rates of compensation for certain
employees in the state classified service.

Whereas, Article XI, Section 5 of the *Constitution of the State of Michigan* of 1963 provides, in relevant part:

Increases in rates of compensation authorized by the commission may be effective only at the start of a fiscal year and shall require prior notice to the governor, who shall transmit such increases to the legislature as part of his budget. The legislature may, by a majority vote of the members elected to and serving in each house, waive the notice and permit increases
