SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 36

Senator Stamas offered the following concurrent resolution:

- 1 A concurrent resolution to approve the State Officers
- 2 Compensation Commission determinations.
- 3 Whereas, Pursuant to the provisions of Article IV, Section 12
- 4 of the Constitution of the State of Michigan of 1963, the State
- 5 Officers Compensation Commission is responsible for making
- 6 determinations regarding the salaries and expense allowances of the
- 7 members of the Legislature, the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor,
- 8 the Attorney General, the Secretary of State, and the Justices of
- 9 the Supreme Court; and
- 10 Whereas, The State Officers Compensation Commission met on May
- 11 7, 2021, to determine the salaries and expense allowances for the
- 12 members of the Legislature, the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor,
- 13 the Attorney General, the Secretary of State, and the Justices of

- 1 the Supreme Court; and
- 2 Whereas, The State Officers Compensation Commission has
- 3 concluded its proceedings and on May 7, 2021, made its
- 4 determinations that the members of the Legislature, the Governor,

- 5 the Lieutenant Governor, the Attorney General, the Secretary of
- 6 State, and the Justices of the Supreme Court should receive a 2
- 7 percent salary increase in both 2023 and 2024. No changes were
- 8 recommended for expense allowances or supplemental salaries; and
- 9 Whereas, On May 11, 2021, the Legislature received the
- 10 determinations of the State Officers Compensation Commission; and
- 11 Whereas, The determinations of the State Officers Compensation
- 12 Commission shall be the salaries and expense allowances only if the
- 13 Legislature approves them by concurrent resolution adopted by a
- 14 majority of the members elected to and serving in each house. If
- 15 the salary and expense determinations are approved, the salary and
- 16 expense determinations shall become effective for the legislative
- 17 session immediately following the next general election, which will
- 18 commence January 1, 2023; now, therefore, be it
- 19 Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives
- 20 concurring), That, pursuant to Article IV, Section 12 of the
- 21 Constitution of the State of Michigan of 1963 and MCL 15.217, we
- 22 hereby approve the determinations of the State Officers
- 23 Compensation Commission that the members of the Legislature, the
- 24 Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the Attorney General, the
- 25 Secretary of State, and the Justices of the Supreme Court should
- 26 receive a 2 percent salary increase in both 2023 and 2024; and be
- 27 it further
- 28 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 29 Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the Attorney General, the

- 1 Secretary of State, the State Court Administrator, and the Director
- 2 of the Department of Technology, Management and Budget.
