- Whereas, Children and youth served by school-based and school-1 2 linked health centers show improved rates of school attendance, enhanced scores on standardized tests, less absenteeism due to 3 illness, and increased immunization rates, while having their 4 wellness and healthcare needs addressed; and 5 6 Whereas, School-Based Health Care Awareness Month is a time to 7 acknowledge the commitment and passion that school-based health 8 center staff and parent/guardians show for all Michigan children 9 and youth; and 10 Whereas, We also recognize the critical role these individuals 11 play in improving the health and well-being of all Michigan 12 children; now, therefore, be it
