- 1 A resolution to declare April 2021 as Distracted Driving
- 2 Awareness Month in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, Distracted driving constitutes a serious threat to
- 4 public safety on Michigan's roads; and
- 5 Whereas, Distracted driving causes hundreds of thousands of
- 6 injuries and thousands of fatalities nationally every year.
- 7 According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration,
- 8 distracted driving tragically claimed the lives of 3,142 Americans

- 1 in 2019, an increase of nearly 10 percent from the year prior; and
- 2 Whereas, We remember all of the lives lost to car accidents
- 3 caused by distracted driving, including the tragic loss of Mitchel
- 4 Kiefer in 2016; and
- 5 Whereas, Drivers from all socio-economic backgrounds, races,
- 6 ethnicities, genders, and ages engage in and are harmed by
- 7 distracted driving; and
- 8 Whereas, Although drivers acknowledge the dangers of
- 9 distracted driving, many still engage in dangerous practices on the
- 10 road. According to the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety, nearly 96
- 11 percent of drivers feel that typing and reading e-mails, text
- 12 messages, or social media while driving is extremely dangerous.
- 13 However, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported
- 14 that nearly 40 percent of teens still engaged in texting while
- 15 driving; and
- 16 Whereas, Michigan law has prohibited texting while driving
- 17 since 2010; and
- 18 Whereas, Michigan's roads would be made safer by a reduction
- 19 in distracted driving; and
- 20 Whereas, The campaign to reduce distracted driving has been
- 21 aided immensely by the efforts of local and state law enforcement
- 22 in Michigan; and
- 23 Whereas, This month dedicated to distracted driving awareness
- 24 will raise public consciousness of the dangers of distracted
- 25 driving in the state of Michigan and will encourage Michiganders
- 26 from all walks of life to put down their telephones while driving;
- 27 now, therefore, be it
- 28 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 29 this legislative body declare April 2021 as Distracted Driving
