Public 4 5 safety telecommunicators are a vital link for our police officers 6 and firefighters by monitoring their activities by radio, providing 7 them information, and ensuring their safety; and 8 Whereas, Public safety telecommunicators have contributed 9 substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of 10 fires, and treatment of patients; now, therefore, be it 11 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of this legislative body declare April 12-April 17, 2021, as Public 12 Safety Telecommunicators Week in the state of Michigan.
