- 1 A resolution to declare February 18, 2022, as Caregivers Day
- 2 in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, February 18 marks National Caregivers Day 2022,
- 4 created in 2015 to recognize in-home caregivers who provide
- 5 personal care and support to enable millions of Americans who are
- 6 aging or who have a disability to remain safe and healthy in their
- 7 own homes; and
- 8 Whereas, Home care has emerged as a valuable solution to fill
- 9 gaps created by traditional care models, including hospitals,
- 10 nursing homes, and home health. Professional caregivers work for

- 1 licensed home care agencies and receive training to enable them to
- 2 assist with activities of daily living such as bathing, dressing,
- 3 and meal preparation. Most importantly, these caregivers provide
- 4 vital companionship and mental stimulation by engaging their
- 5 clients in conversation and other activities; and
- 6 Whereas, Professional caregivers, who number nearly 4.6
- 7 million in the United States and family caregivers who are an
- 8 estimated at 44 million, are lifelines to millions of Americans
- 9 while keeping them safe, healthy, and engaged. Important benefits
- 10 of home care include helping seniors lead more independent lives,
- 11 preventing falls and other common injuries, promoting medication
- 12 adherence, and reducing social isolation; and
- 13 Whereas, The home care industry is among the fastest growing
- 14 healthcare industries in the United States and the Home Care
- 15 Association Michigan Chapter continuously advocates on behalf of
- 16 our providers and professional caregivers who have been essential
- 17 in the fight against COVID-19; and
- 18 Whereas, Caregivers have stepped up to the challenge of COVID-
- 19, not only caring for their clients but also risking their own
- 20 personal health and safety while doing so; and
- 21 Whereas, Home care workers enable families to stay together at
- 22 home safely and with dignity as they age; now, therefore, be it
- 23 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 24 this legislative body declare February 18, 2022, as Caregivers Day
- 25 in the state of Michigan. We express our gratitude to caregivers
- 26 for their unwavering commitment to the care of their clients and
- 27 families, especially during the COVID-19 pandemic.
