## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.337

Reps. Camilleri, Breen, Brixie, Clemente, Garza, Glanville, Haadsma, Hope, Cynthia Johnson, Kuppa, Manoogian, Marino, Morse, Rogers, Sneller, Sowerby and Stone offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to declare September 21, 2022, as Maltese
- 2 American Heritage Day in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, Malta is a country in the central Mediterranean Sea
- 4 with a rich and unique history dating back thousands of years.
- 5 Because of its strategic location, this archipelago of six islands
- 6 has been a naval asset for centuries and was also instrumental in
- 7 World War II. After coming under siege by Axis Powers, the ensuing
- 8 Allied offensive to regain the island was successful and was
- 9 instrumental in the following North African campaign. Malta would
- 10 eventually gain its independence from the United Kingdom on

- 1 September 21, 1964 and became a Republic in 1974. Today, Malta is a
- 2 unitary multiparty Republic, with a parliament consisting of a
- 3 unicameral House of Representatives. Despite its small geographic
- 4 size, Malta is the fourth most densely populated country in Europe
- 5 and the eighth most in the world, with a population of nearly
- 6 450,000 spread across approximately 121 square miles. Among other
- 7 unique attributes, Malta boasts three UNESCO heritage sites,
- 8 delicious cuisine, world-renowned diving and other recreational
- 9 opportunities on its stunning coastline, and some of the oldest
- 10 freestanding structures in the world; and
- 11 Whereas, The United States is fortunate to be home to more
- 12 than 42,000 Maltese Americans. The United States Census Bureau
- 13 estimates that nearly 12,500 Michiganders are Maltese immigrants or
- 14 children of Maltese immigrants, making the Metro Detroit area the
- 15 largest concentration of Maltese Americans in the nation.
- 16 Michiganders of Maltese descent, from the auto workers that helped
- 17 build Michigan into an industrial powerhouse to the entrepreneurs
- 18 who opened restaurants that are still serving the Metro Detroit
- 19 community today, have employed the Maltese values of creativity,
- 20 perseverance, and relentless hard work to build a better future for
- 21 their families and the communities they call home. Both the state
- 22 of Michigan and the United States of America have been enriched by
- 23 the contributions of Maltese Americans in all facets of life,
- 24 including the arts, sciences, business, education, and
- 25 philanthropy; and
- 26 Whereas, Maltese American residents are proudly served in
- 27 Michigan by the Maltese American Benevolent Society in Detroit and
- 28 the Maltese American Community Club in Dearborn; and
- 29 Whereas, Michigan views cultural diversity as a strength and

- 1 welcomes the opportunity to honor our fellow Michiganders of
- 2 Maltese descent for their lasting and expanding imprint upon our
- 3 state; now, therefore, be it
- 4 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 5 this legislative body declare September 21, 2022, as Maltese
- 6 American Heritage Day in the state of Michigan. We encourage all
- 7 citizens to celebrate the individual and collective contributions
- 8 of Maltese Americans to this state and to this country.
