- 6 childhood experiences significantly reduces a child's chances for
- 7 success; and
- 8 Whereas, Children thrive when under the influence of a one-to-
- 9 one mentoring relationship with an adult; and
- 10 Whereas, Big Brothers Big Sisters agencies have helped

- 1 hundreds of thousands of young people successfully navigate life's
- 2 challenges and achieve success through fostering one-to-one
- 3 mentoring relationships since its founding in 1904; and
- 4 Whereas, The need for mentoring relationships continues to
- 5 grow statewide, with statistics showing a need for thousands of
- 6 youth in need of adult mentors; and
- 7 Whereas, Volunteer mentors provide their mentees with a safe
- 8 place and support network to help at-risk youth reach their full
- 9 potential; and
- 10 Whereas, The Big Brothers Big Sisters agencies in the state of
- 11 Michigan have recently formed the Big Brothers Big Sisters Alliance
- 12 of Michigan to increase resources and create opportunities that
- 13 sustain and grow program services across the state; and
- 14 Whereas, Youth with mentors are less likely to skip school,
- 15 use alcohol and drugs, drop out of school, and are more likely to
- 16 reach a higher level of education, be financially literate, find a
- 17 full-time job or career, volunteer in the community, and lead a
- 18 healthy lifestyle; and
- 19 Whereas, The Big Brothers Big Sisters Alliance of Michigan
- 20 believes in changing outcomes for Michigan's at-risk youth and
- 21 reversing the downward spiral brought on by poverty and adverse
- 22 childhood experiences by fostering one-to-one mentoring
- 23 relationships, and
- 24 Whereas, The House of Representatives is committed to helping
- 25 Michigan's children find success throughout their academics and
- 26 careers; now, therefore, be it
- 27 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That members of the
- 28 legislative body declare September 2022 as Big Brothers Big Sisters
- 29 Youth Mentoring Month in the state of Michigan.
