HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.350

Reps. Shannon, Breen, Haadsma, Hope, Kuppa, Manoogian, Rabhi, Stone and Weiss offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to declare October 2022 as Filipino American
- 2 History Month in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, Michigan is home to more than 32,000 individuals
- 4 claiming Filipino heritage, who have had a profound and positive
- 5 impact on this state; and
- 6 Whereas, October was the month selected by the Filipino
- 7 American Historical Society (FANHS) because it was October 1587 in
- 8 Morro Bay, California, that the first known Filipinos arrived in
- 9 America; and
- 10 Whereas, Since immigrants from the Philippines first
- 11 established their roots in Michigan, they have become leaders in

- 1 every aspect of our communities, enriching our schools, businesses,
- 2 civic life, and social organizations across the state; and
- 3 Whereas, Filipino Americans have contributed greatly to music,
- 4 dance, literature, journalism, sports, fashion, politics,
- 5 government, science, technology, the fine arts, and other fields in
- 6 the U.S. that enrich the landscape of this country; and
- 7 Whereas, These contributions reflect a culture which values
- 8 and prioritizes family and community, which takes pride in hard
- 9 work and diligence, and which celebrates its collective identity;

- 11 Whereas, It is imperative for Filipino-American youth to have
- 12 positive role models to instill in them the significance of
- 13 education, complemented with the richness of their ethnicity and
- 14 the value of their legacy; and
- 15 Whereas, Filipino Americans have also improved our state
- 16 through their commitment to fostering institutions that have helped
- 17 to eliminate prejudices and stereotypes and establish the kind of
- 18 cross-cultural dialogue and understanding that makes our state a
- 19 diverse and welcoming place for all; and
- Whereas, Thanks in no small part to the efforts of Michigan's
- 21 Filipino Americans, the United States continues to strengthen its
- 22 relationship with the Filipino American community and to continue
- 23 to promote the culture, values, history and traditions of the
- 24 Philippines; now, therefore, be it
- 25 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 26 this legislative body declare October 2022 as Filipino American
- 27 History Month in the state of Michigan; and be it further
- 28 Resolved, That with the declaration of Filipino American
- 29 History Month, we acknowledge and celebrate the contributions of

- 1 Filipino Americans, who have greatly enriched Michigan's economy,
- 2 civic life, and state culture.
