4 our values as Michiganders and Americans. As civic leaders, it is
5 our duty to promote respect, inclusion, and a welcoming community
6 for people of all races, national origins, and ethnicities; and

7 Whereas, All Michiganders can play a role in establishing a
8 safe and welcoming community by intervening and reporting instances
9 of hate and discrimination. Reporting these incidents is critical
10 to holding perpetrators accountable and fully addressing the issue;
11 now, therefore, be it

12 Resolved by the Senate, That we condemn hate crimes, hateful
13 rhetoric, and hateful acts against Asian Americans; and be it
14 further

15 Resolved, That we encourage Asian Americans and all
16 Michiganders who experience hate crimes to report such incidents to
17 local law enforcement or the Michigan Attorney General's Hate
18 Crimes Unit; and be it further

19 Resolved, That we encourage Asian Americans and all
20 Michiganders who experience discrimination to report such
21 experiences to the Michigan Department of Civil Rights; and be it
22 further

23 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
24 Governor, the Michigan Attorney General, and the Director of the
25 Michigan Department of Civil Rights.
