- 12 Keller, Clara Barton, Laura Ingalls Wilder, Franklin D. Roosevelt,
- 13 George Patton, Douglas MacArthur, Frank Lloyd Wright, John Philip
- 14 Sousa, and Tim Tebow among many others; and
- 15 Whereas, Michigan's home educated students are equipped to be
- 16 successful, informed, engaged, ethical, and productive citizens who
