## SENATE RESOLUTION NO.78

Senators Zorn and Barrett offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare support for the people of Cuba in 2 their fight against a destructive Communist regime and to urge the United States government and the Biden Administration to take 3 action to protect the basic human rights of the Cuban people. 4 Whereas, Communist Miguel Díaz-Canel rose to power in Cuba in 6 2018 and continues to follow the failed policies of Fidel and Raúl Castro. President Díaz-Canel's ascension has coincided with an 7 economic crisis that led to a heavy-handed and nonsensical shutdown 8 9 of the state-run communication system and purposeful electricity 10 outages; and 11 Whereas, The Cuban people lack the freedom to be in charge of their own destiny and future as a result of the systemic and 12 continued repression they face at the hands of the Diaz-Canal 13

- 2 Whereas, A historic and remarkable gathering of protests is
- 3 occurring in Cuba, where everyday Cubans are courageously demanding

- 4 democracy, liberty, economic security, food, and basic medical
- 5 necessities. Liberty in Cuba is defined as not only economic
- 6 liberty, but also civil liberties. This includes the right to vote,
- 7 liberty of conscience, and the right to self-determination. At the
- 8 heart of these protests is the will of Cuban people to be in charge
- 9 of their own destiny; and
- 10 Whereas, Without democracy and free elections, the welfare of
- 11 the Cuban people will continue to be structurally burdened and
- 12 protests will continue. As the Communist regime continues to
- 13 deprive the people of Cuba of peaceful means to improve their
- 14 lives, everyday Cubans will continue to risk their lives and well-
- 15 being to protest openly to demand immediate change; and
- 16 Whereas, Michigan is a state that values our best aspirational
- 17 American ideals of liberty, tolerance, and freedom. These are the
- 18 ideals and values that Cubans march for today. The people of
- 19 Michigan support the right of the people of Cuba to peacefully
- 20 protest to secure basic civil liberties, and stand with the people
- 21 of Cuba in support of their quest for democracy, liberty, and
- 22 freedom; now, therefore, be it
- 23 Resolved by the Senate, That we declare support for the people
- 24 of Cuba in their fight against a destructive Communist regime and
- 25 urge the United States government and the Biden Administration to
- 26 take action to protect the basic human rights of the Cuban people;
- 27 and be it further
- 28 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 29 President of the United States, the Speaker of the United States

- 1 House of Representatives, the President of the United States
- 2 Senate, and the members of the Michigan congressional delegation.
