SENATE RESOLUTION NO.80

Senators Lauwers, Santana, Chang and Geiss offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to commemorate August 31, 2021, as Overdose
- 2 Awareness Day.
- 3 Whereas, Drug overdose deaths are the leading cause of injury
- 4 or death in the United States; and
- 5 Whereas, Since 2000, drug overdose deaths are nine times
- 6 higher in the state of Michigan, the majority of which are a result
- 7 of prescription opioids, illicit fentanyl (synthetic opioid), and
- 8 heroin; and
- 9 Whereas, More people in Michigan and across the United States
- 10 died from drug overdoses in 2020 than ever before; and
- 11 Whereas, More specifically, overdose deaths in Michigan

- 1 increased more than 16 percent between 2019 and 2020, accounting
- 2 for nearly 2,770 overdose deaths in 2020; and
- 3 Whereas, Overdose deaths were up nearly 30 percent across the
- 4 nation in 2020, accounting for more than 93,000 deaths; and
- 5 Whereas, The families and friends of overdose victims suffer
- 6 unspeakable grief and heartache from the loss of their loved ones;
- 7 and
- **8** Whereas, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)
- 9 have categorized prescription and synthetic drug substance abuse as
- 10 the nation's top public health epidemics; and
- 11 Whereas, Substance abuse disorder is a neurological disease
- 12 that over 20 million Americans are afflicted with; and
- 13 Whereas, The ongoing stigmatization of substance abuse
- 14 disorder results in many Americans not seeking the mental health
- 15 treatment and medical care they need to recover from their
- 16 addiction, resulting in increased overdose deaths; and
- 17 Whereas, Substance abuse disorder also has tremendous social
- 18 and economic consequences in America, including increased costs to
- 19 our health care and criminal justice systems, losses in job
- 20 productivity, threats to public safety, and the erosion of
- 21 families; and
- 22 Whereas, The public health addiction and overdose crisis
- 23 requires a multi-pronged solution that engages law enforcement,
- 24 health professionals, policymakers, and the general public; and
- 25 Whereas, The multi-stakeholder Michigan Prescription Drug and
- 26 Opioid Abuse Task Force is creating a statewide action plan to
- 27 address this widespread disease; and
- 28 Whereas, The recommendations of the Michigan Prescription Drug
- 29 and Opioid Abuse Task Force have the potential to reduce the number

- 1 of drug overdose deaths in Michigan; and
- 2 Whereas, August 31, 2021, is observed as International
- 3 Overdose Awareness Day; now, therefore, be it
- 4 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 5 body commemorate August 31, 2021, as Overdose Awareness Day. We
- 6 encourage all of Michigan's citizens to participate in the aims and
- 7 goals of this effort.
