- 1 A resolution to designate November 2021 as "Do Business with a Veteran Month".
- 3 Whereas, United States (U.S.) military veterans, 634,000 from
- 4 the state of Michigan, have sacrificed over the years for our
- 5 liberties and freedoms, including the right to open a business; and
- 6 Whereas, Members and veterans of the Armed Forces of the
- 7 United States develop a wide array of skills during their time of
- 8 service that support entrepreneurship; and
- 9 Whereas, Many veterans build on their experience in the Armed
- 10 Forces to start their own business after leaving active service;

- 12 Whereas, Veterans form a vital part of the U.S. and Michigan's

- 1 labor force, and companies that hire veterans benefit from their
- 2 diverse set of skills; and
- 3 Whereas, Veteran-owned businesses make up almost six percent
- 4 of all businesses in the U.S., with an estimated \$947.7 billion in
- 5 receipts, approximately 3.9 million employees, and about \$177.7
- 6 billion in annual payroll; and
- 7 Whereas, There are over 44,000 veteran-owned small businesses
- 8 in the state of Michigan; and
- 9 Whereas, We owe our gratitude, thanks, and respect to those
- 10 veterans, the businesses they run, and the businesses that hire
- 11 them and wish to show our appreciation for their role in securing
- 12 our nation and liberty; now, therefore, be it
- Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 14 body designate November 2021 as "Do Business with a Veteran Month";
- 15 and be it further
- 16 Resolved, That we encourage all Michigan citizens to seek out
- 17 veteran-owned businesses and companies that hire veterans and honor
- 18 them by doing business with them, not only in the month of
- 19 November, but also year-round.
