Senators Bumstead, Outman and Chang offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to designate June 2022 as Internet Safety Month.

2 Whereas, Internet Safety Month provides Michigan residents

3 with an opportunity to learn more about the dangers of the Internet

4 and the importance of being safe and responsible online; and

5 Whereas, The Michigan Child Protection Registry was created by

6 the state Legislature in 2004 as a do-not-contact service for our

7 families. This registry, administered by the Michigan Secretary of

8 State and enforced by the Attorney General's Office, is a free

9 program that allows families to protect their households from

10 adult-oriented messages; and

11 Whereas, The Michigan Child Protection Registry honors

- 1 Internet Safety Month by reminding parents and guardians that, upon
- 2 signing up for this registry, they can stop adult-oriented
- 3 advertisements including alcohol, tobacco, pornography, online
- 4 gambling, and illegal drugs from reaching their family's email
- 5 inboxes, cell phones, or instant messenger IDs; and
- 6 Whereas, We commend state and community organizations for
- 7 promoting awareness about the dangers of the Internet and for
- 8 providing information and training that develops the critical
- 9 thinking and decision-making skills needed to be safe online; and
- 10 Whereas, We call on Internet safety organizations, law
- 11 enforcement, educators, community leaders, parents, and volunteers
- 12 to increase their efforts to ensure online safety here in Michigan
- 13 and the United States; now, therefore, be it
- 14 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 15 body designate June 2022 as Internet Safety Month; and be it
