SENATE RESOLUTION NO.159

Senators Barrett, Chang, Geiss, Santana, Theis and Wojno offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to commemorate June 27, 2022, as Post-Traumatic
- 2 Stress Injury (PTSI) Awareness Day.
- 3 Whereas, The brave men and women of the United States (U.S.)
- 4 Armed Forces risk their lives to protect the freedom of the United
- 5 States and deserve the investment of every possible resource to
- 6 ensure their lasting physical, mental, and emotional well-being;
- 7 and
- 8 Whereas, More than 2,000,000 U.S. service members have
- 9 deployed as part of overseas contingency operations since the
- 10 events of September 11, 2001; and
- 11 Whereas, The military has sustained an operational tempo for a

- 1 period of time unprecedented in the history of the U.S., with many
- 2 service members deploying multiple times to combat zones, placing
- 3 them at high risk of PTSI; and
- 4 Whereas, It is expected that 10,000 veterans will return to
- 5 Michigan every year for the next three to five years after spending
- 6 a significant amount of time in combat environments, exposing
- 7 thousands of soldiers to traumatic life threatening events; and
- 8 Whereas, In fiscal year 2012, the U.S. Department of Veterans
- 9 Affairs reported that more than 500,000 veterans from all wars who
- 10 sought care at a Department of Veterans Affairs medical center
- 11 received treatment for PTSI; and
- 12 Whereas, PTSI significantly increases the risk of depression,
- 13 suicide, and drug or alcohol-related disorders and deaths; and
- 14 Whereas, Thousands of Michigan corrections professionals who
- 15 perform a critical and dangerous job protecting the public suffer
- 16 health detriments due to high stress and potentially traumatic
- 17 occupational experiences. Recent studies have shown that nearly
- 18 33.7 percent of surveyed corrections officers are estimated to be
- 19 PTSI positive in this state; and
- 20 Whereas, The U.S. Department of Defense and the U.S.
- 21 Department of Veterans Affairs have made significant advances in
- 22 the causes, symptoms, prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of PTSI.
- 23 However, many challenges remain; and
- 24 Whereas, The establishment of a Post-Traumatic Stress Injury
- 25 Awareness Day in Michigan raises public awareness about issues
- 26 related to PTSI; now, therefore, be it
- 27 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 28 body commemorate June 27, 2022, as Post-Traumatic Stress Injury
- 29 (PTSI) Awareness Day; and be it further

- 1 Resolved, That we urge the Michigan Veterans Affairs Agency
- 2 and the Adjutant General to continue working to educate service
- 3 members, veterans, the families of service members and veterans,
- 4 and the public about the causes, symptoms, and treatment of PTSI;
- 5 and be it further
- 6 Resolved, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 7 Governor of the state of Michigan.
