

SENATE RESOLUTION NO.179

Senators Shirkey and Ananich offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution of tribute for the Honorable Adam Hollier.

2 Whereas, The members of this legislative body recognize the
3 Honorable Adam Hollier's commendable service as the senator for the
4 Second District, of which he is a lifelong resident. Since assuming
5 office in 2018, Senator Hollier has served his constituents in
6 Wayne County and all of Michigan's citizens with honor; and

7 Whereas, Senator Hollier brought an array of personal,
8 professional, and educational experiences to his tenure as a
9 Senator. Before assuming office, the lifelong Detroit resident and
10 proud graduate of the Detroit Public School system served his
11 community as a volunteer firefighter. Senator Hollier was
12 commissioned as a second lieutenant after graduating with
13 distinction from officer candidate school. Senator Hollier

1 currently serves as Captain, paratrooper, and team leader in the
2 Four-twelfth Civil Affairs Battalion Airborne, demonstrating his
3 stalwart commitment to serving his fellow citizens. Senator Hollier
4 holds a bachelor's degree in industrial and labor relations from
5 Cornell University and a master's degree in urban planning from the
6 University of Michigan. He began his career in public service as a
7 staffer in the state legislature and for local Detroit officials,
8 where in both capacities he worked on various successful projects
9 benefiting the residents of Detroit. He is also the former
10 director of government affairs for the Michigan Fitness Foundation.
11 Such dedication and drive certainly influenced the performance of
12 his duties as Senator. He is the dedicated husband to Krystle and
13 father to a young daughter and son; and

14 Whereas, Senator Hollier's record in the legislature is a
15 testament to his successful advocacy on behalf of his constituency.
16 Senator Hollier has prioritized bringing back money to his
17 district, noting that budgets are the physical prioritization of
18 our values. Senator Hollier served on many committees including as
19 the minority vice chair of the Joint Committee on Administrative
20 Rules and as the minority vice chair of the Appropriations
21 subcommittees on Corrections and Judiciary, Military and Veterans
22 Affairs/State Police, and Transportation. He also served as a
23 member of the committee on Transportation and Infrastructure as
24 well as Appropriations and the subcommittees on Community
25 Health/Human Services, Justice and Public Safety, Talent and
26 Economic Development/MEDC. During his tenure, Senator Hollier
27 focused on developing educational and economic opportunities for
28 Michiganians across the state and sponsored legislation to address
29 a variety of issues, including, among others, electoral and

1 criminal justice reform, the expansion of civil rights protections,
2 and creating funding for expanding veterans' homes in our state;
3 now, therefore, be it

5 tribute to commend and thank the Honorable Adam Hollier for his
6 notable contributions to this legislative body and to our state;
