HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.68

Reps. Witwer, Manoogian, Puri, Haadsma, Tyrone Carter, Steenland and Peterson offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution to declare March 29, 2021, as Vietnam Veterans
- 2 Day in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, Vietnam Veterans Day commemorates the sacrifices of
- 4 Vietnam veterans and their families; and
- 5 Whereas, The Vietnam War was fought in Vietnam from 1955-1975,
- 6 and involved North Vietnam and the Viet Cong in conflict with the
- 7 United States Armed Forces and South Vietnam; and
- 8 Whereas, The United States became involved by serving in an
- 9 advisory role in South Vietnam in 1955; and
- 10 Whereas, In 1965, United States Armed Forces ground combat
- 11 units arrived in Vietnam. In 1969, troop numbers peaked at
- 12 approximately 500,000 troops. Michigan residents joined the rest of

- 1 the nation, serving our country and our state with honor in
- 2 Vietnam; and
- 3 Whereas, On January 27, 1973, the Treaty of Paris was signed
- 4 which required the release of all United States prisoners-of-war
- 5 held in North Vietnam and the withdrawal of all United States Armed
- 6 Forces from South Vietnam. By March 29, 1973, the United States
- 7 Armed Forces completed the withdrawal of combat troops from
- 8 Vietnam; and
- 9 Whereas, More than 58,000 members of the United States Armed
- 10 Forces lost their lives in Vietnam and more than 300,000 members of
- 11 the Armed Forces were wounded. More than 2,650 Michigan residents
- 12 lost their lives in the Vietnam War; and
- 13 Whereas, It was not until 1982 that the Vietnam Veterans
- 14 Memorial was dedicated in Washington, D.C. to commemorate those
- 15 members of the United States Armed Forces who died or were declared
- 16 missing-in-action in Vietnam; and
- 17 Whereas, Members of the United States Armed Forces who served
- 18 bravely and faithfully for the United States during the Vietnam War
- 19 were caught upon their return home in the crossfire of public
- 20 debate about the involvement of the United States in the Vietnam
- 21 War; and
- 22 Whereas, March 29 marks the anniversary of the day that combat
- 23 and combat support units withdrew completely from South Vietnam;

- 25 Whereas, The members of the Michigan House of Representatives
- 26 support the establishment of a Vietnam Veterans Day as an
- 27 appropriate way to honor those members of the United States Armed
- 28 Forces who served in Vietnam during the Vietnam War and more than
- 29 200,000 Vietnam Veterans living in Michigan; now, therefore, be it

- 1 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 2 this legislative body declare March 29, 2021, as Vietnam Veterans
- 3 Day; and be it further
- 4 Resolved, That all citizens of the state of Michigan are
- 5 encouraged to honor our Vietnam veterans.
