The prompt response of 7 police officers, firefighters, and paramedics is critical to the 8 protection of life and preservation of property. The safety of our 9 police officers and firefighters is dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who telephone 911 10 11 emergency communications centers; and 12 Whereas, Public safety telecommunicators demonstrate great

- 2 job. Public safety telecommunicators are the first and most
- 3 critical contact Michiganders have with emergency services. Public
- 4 safety telecommunicators are a vital link for our police officers
- 5 and firefighters by monitoring their activities by radio, providing
- 6 them information, and ensuring their safety; and
- 7 Whereas, Public safety telecommunicators have contributed
- 8 substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of
- 9 fires, and treatment of patients; now, therefore, be it
- 10 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 11 this legislative body declare April 12-April 17, 2021, as Public
- 12 Safety Telecommunicators Week in the state of Michigan. We
- 13 recognize the contributions that telecommunicators have made to
- 14 Michigan's communities; and be it further
- 15 Resolved, That we commend public safety telecommunicators for
- 16 helping to ensure the safety of our communities throughout
- 17 Michigan.
