Whereas, The office of the municipal clerk is the longest 1 serving profession among public servants; and 2 3 Whereas, It provides the professional link between the citizens, local governing bodies, and agencies of government at 4 5 other levels; and 6 Whereas, Municipal clerks have pledged to be ever mindful of 7 their neutrality and impartiality, rendering service to all; and 8 Whereas, The municipal clerk serves as the information center 9 on functions of local government and the community; and 10 Whereas, Municipal clerks continually strive to improve the 11 administration of the affairs of the office of the municipal clerk through participation in education programs, seminars, workshops, 12 13 and the annual meetings of their state, province, county, and 14 international professional organizations; and 15 Whereas, The municipal clerk maintains and oversees the integrity of local, state and national elections within the 16 community ensuring that all residents have the opportunity to vote 17 18 and that their vote will count; now, therefore, be it 19 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of 20 this legislative body declare May 2-8, 2021, as Professional Municipal Clerks Week in the state of Michigan. We proclaim this 21 week in recognition of the accomplishments and contributions of the 22 23 office of the municipal clerk in the state of Michigan; and be it 24 further 25 Resolved, That we extend our deepest appreciation to our 26 municipal clerks for the vital services they perform and the 27 exemplary dedication to the communities they serve.
