- 3 Whereas, The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services,
- 4 the Association for Children's Mental Health, Michigan behavioral
- 5 health care providers, quality improvement partners, and behavioral
- 6 health advocates as well as the children and youth with lived
- 7 experience, and their families through their unique approach and
- 8 expertise in serving children and adolescents, are effectively
- 9 caring for the mental health needs of children, youth, and families
- 10 in our community; and
- 11 Whereas, It is appropriate that a day should be set apart each
- 12 year for the direction of our thoughts toward our children's mental
- 13 health and well-being; and
- 14 Whereas, This resolution calls attention to the importance of
- 15 children's mental health and well-being and observance of the
- 16 annual National Children's Mental Health Awareness Day on May 7;
- 17 now, therefore, be it
- 18 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 19 this legislative body declare May 7, 2021, as Children's Mental
- 20 Health Awareness Day in the state of Michigan.
