

## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.193

Reps. Tate, Green, Sabo, Hope, Haadsma, Coleman, Shannon, Steckloff, Scott, Cavanagh, Sowerby, Witwer, Breen, Camilleri, Lasinski, Stone and Kuppa offered the following resolution:

1       A resolution to declare November 17, 2021, as Auto Heritage  
2 Day in the state of Michigan.

3       Whereas, Michigan's distinctive automotive heritage is  
4 preserved and promoted by the MotorCities National Heritage Area  
5 Partnership, an affiliate of the National Park Service; and

6       Whereas, The MotorCities National Heritage Area tells stories  
7 about how Michigan "Put the World on Wheels" throughout a region of  
8 10,000 square miles in 16 Michigan counties, with a population of  
9 more than six million people; and

10       Whereas, These unique stories are used to advance our state  
11 both culturally and economically; and

1       Whereas, The MotorCities National Heritage Area is the largest  
2 concentration of auto-related sites, attractions, and events in the  
3 world, bringing in millions of visitors each year; and

4       Whereas, Annually, the MotorCities National Heritage Area  
5 generates \$490 million in economic impact, including \$40 million in  
6 tax revenue and over 5,300 jobs; and

7       Whereas, For the eighth consecutive year, the MotorCities  
8 National Heritage Area, in partnership with the Michigan  
9 Legislative Auto Caucus, has organized Michigan Auto Heritage Day,  
10 where supporters of automotive heritage preservation come together  
11 in celebration of the state's unique automotive history; and

12       Whereas, The Michigan Legislative Auto Caucus allows members  
13 to exchange ideas and influence policy, including auto heritage  
14 policy; now, therefore, be it

15       Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of  
16 this legislative body declare November 17, 2021, as Auto Heritage  
17 Day in the state of Michigan.
